Universal Turtle Sacred Shell Concept

The relationship with the Turtle is very sacred. The Turtle is a reminder of our connection to creation and Mother Earth. She shares the knowledge and understanding of our people, and while we are carried on her back, we are guided, safe, loved, and nourished. When we have to learn lessons of life, she gently pushes us off her back, so we may walk on our own journey and continue our Earth Walk, while carrying our own children on our back.

The Universal Turtle Sacred Shell Concept assists children, youth and families create a visual tool to communicate their hopes, needs, goals, and objectives. This tool helps create a collaborative plan and reminds us of responsibilities, community connections, and the importance of creating and maintaining connections to culture and healing. The Sacred Shell is a reminder of our teachings, the interconnectedness of all, and serves as a visual guide on our Earth Walk to Mino Bimaadiziwin: *The Good Life*.
