#### Wiisnidaa- Let's eat!

Hominy Corn Soup
Source: LTBB Odawak FDPIR and Community Health programs

#### Ingredients

- 1 to 11/2 pounds pork loin, chops, cubed
- 4 15.5 oz. cans hominy, drained and rinsed
- 5 or 6 medium-sized potatoes, peeled and diced
- 2 or 3 15.5 oz. cans kidney beans, drained and rinsed
- Salt and pepper

#### Instructions:

- 1. Wash your hands before preparing food.
- 2.Place pork pieces in large pot with 1  $V_2$  quarts of water. Add  $V_2$  teaspoon salt and simmer for about 1 hour.
- 3.Add the drained and rinsed hominy to pot. Continue to boil together gently for another hour.
- 4.In the meantime, boil the potatoes separately in a pan of salted water until just tender. Drain, and discard water. Cool potatoes to prevent from further cooking
- 5. After 2 hours, add the potatoes and drained and rinsed kidney beans to cooking pot. Add additional 1 quart of water, or more to desired consistency. Reheat to boiling and serve with salt and pepper.

#### Notes and Ideas:

- $\bullet$  You may add more cans of hominy, if you prefer.
- If you use a fattier cut of pork, you may decide to remove and discard any excess fat from the meat and skim the fat from the cooking water, before adding the hominy.
